WORKING IN IRELAND

How to get a PPS Number?

The PPS number can be presented as the equivalent of the French social security number. You need it to be fully paid.

You can apply online following the next steps :

- Set up a basic at MyGovID Account at <https://www.mygovid.ie/>
- Go to [MyWelfare.ie](https://www.mywelfare.ie/) and apply online for a PPSN.

Checklist to apply for PPSN :

- **Proof of ID** = Your Passport / National ID
- **Evidence of why you need a PPSN** = signed offer of employment from your employer confirming when your job is due to start or when it started
- **Proof of Irish address** = stamped letter from your accommodation, or letter from your landlord

The PPS number typically takes up to a month to process and will be issued by post to the address provided by the student.

How to open a bank account in Ireland?

-> You do not need to open an Irish bank account when you want to work in Ireland but you can open one if you want

What documents do you need to open a bank account?

- Proof of ID
- Proof of Irish address
